



No Expiration Date on the Authority of the Righteous

As we turn the page from 2022 to 2023, let's remember that God's Word to us on December 31, 2021, *The Year of the Authority of the Righteous*, has not expired. The authority of the righteous does not end on a calendar date.

Time Does Not Weaken God's Word

Psalm 119:89-90 says, For ever,
O Lord, thy word is settled in heaven.
Thy faithfulness is unto all
generations: thou hast established
the earth, and it abideth. God's
Word endures forever. From
the moment it flowed from the
Holy Ghost to those who penned
the Scriptures to this very day,
God's Word works. Jesus put the
permanence of God's Word this way:
Heaven and earth shall pass away,
but my words shall not pass away.
(Matthew 24:35) In the same way,

the Word God gave me for 2022 still stands. It doesn't matter what last year brought. The devil may have kicked up a bunch of trouble for you, but that does not change God's Word! You still have authority over the devil and his demons. Don't allow the passing of time to weaken your stand against evil. Time does not impair God's Word.

We are accustomed to expiration dates on food and medicine. Nearly everything you buy at your local grocery store comes with a "use by" date. Some food items become poisonous after their expiration date; other things lose their taste or effectiveness. But the Word of God is not like your mayonnaise, eggs, or multivitamins! It always gives life, and its power never diminishes. God's Word does not weaken with time or expire.

Seasons

Nature is marked by seasons. My home state of Michigan experiences all four seasons in their fullness. Genesis 8:22 says the earth will always go through seasons as it operates on the law of seed, time, and harvest. It reads, While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease. Our personal lives and corporate lives as a nation and the body of Christ also go through seasons. A season is a period of time that has a beginning and an end. Nations and groups of people can experience seasons of blessing or seasons of cursing. We are currently in a season of high judgment, but God's people are not powerless. When we do 1 John 1:9 and confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. When Christians do what God says, their authority is restored. Believers can turn their own lives and the lives of those around them, from being cursed to being blessed.

Judgment

We often understand the word judgment to be a negative word, but judgment can be positive or negative. If a judge decides in your favor, the judgment is positive. If not, judgment is negative.





You're probably familiar with the negative judgment of Sodom and Gomorrah; the prophet Isaiah reminded his readers of it in Isaiah chapter one. It says, Hear the word of the Lord, ve rulers of Sodom; give ear unto the law of our God, ve people of Gomorrah. To what purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices unto me? saith the Lord: I am full of the burnt offerings of rams, and the fat of fed beasts; and I delight not in the blood of bullocks, or of lambs, or of he goats. When ye come to appear before me, who hath required this at your hand, to tread my courts? Bring no more vain oblations: incense is an abomination unto me: the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; it is iniquity, even the solemn meeting. Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hateth: they are a trouble unto me; I am weary to bear them. (Isaiah 1:10-14)

We don't offer bulls and goats to God today, but we offer Him worship. Our worship, like those of the Old Testament, can be sincere, which pleases God, and brings positive judgment, or nothing more than a show, which does not please the Lord.

God Will Turn Judgment from Negative to Positive When Believers Do This *Isaiah 1:15 continues*, describing the sin of Israel and the impending negative judgment. As you read the following verse, ask yourself if this applies to your community, nation, or the world. It reads, *And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear: your hands are full of blood.*

We are under negative judgment today because so many hands are full of blood, but God is so good; He always makes a way for those under negative judgment to turn back to Him and reverse the curse. Right after Isaiah spoke about the sins of God's people, he offered the solution. Isaiah 1:16-20 says, Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil: Learn to do well: seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow. Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your

sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool. If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land: But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it. When believers repent (turn from evil) and become willing and obedient, the land will be good again.

God Is Restoring

The reason Paul told Timothy to pray for those in authority is so we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. (1 Timothy 2:2) In other words, what politicians and bureaucrats do affects everyone, and it has always been that way. As Ecclesiastes 1:9 says, there is no new thing under the sun. Isaiah 1:23-26 talks about rebellious princes and crooked judges, and it also offers hope of restoration of righteousness. It reads, Thy princes are rebellious, and companions of thieves: every one loveth gifts, and followeth after rewards: they judge not the fatherless, neither doth the cause of the widow come unto them.

Therefore saith the Lord, the Lord of hosts, the mighty One of Israel, Ah, I will ease me of mine adversaries, and avenge me of mine enemies: And I will turn my hand upon thee, and purely purge away thy dross, and take away all thy tin: And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.

God called 2022 the **Year of the** Authority of the Righteous, and the obedient and willing people of God exercised their authority over sickness, bringing a worldwide pandemic to an end. What happens in the future, leading up to the rapture, is up to the church of the Living God. As we operate in the Spirit realm, speaking God's Word with Jesus' authority, things will line up with God's will. Many have had their health restored by taking their authority. Now, as the body of Christ continues to exercise the authority they have in Jesus, finances, families, and futures are also being restored. God's people are being respected again. Restoration is happening.


Whatever the enemy brought against you will no longer have power over you as you move away from the things of the flesh, pull closer to God, walk with Him, and speak His Word.

Is in our 2nd year of providing a Christ-centered, virtual education for Kindergarten-5th graders

We have students enrolled from Michigan, Texas and Canada.

After 10 weeks of instruction, 60% of our scholars ranked in the 75th percentile or higher in reading on the internationally recognized NWEA Map Growth Assessment. 65% of our scholars scored in the 70th percentile or higher in Math on the same assessment.

We value our partnership between parents, scholars and instructors. During our Goal Setting Conferences, we collaborated to develop personalized learning plans and goals at the start of the school year. Plans were then designed to identify areas where additional support is needed and areas where scholars can be challenged and accelerated. Goals were set, monitored and adjusted to insure our scholars' continued growth.

Our mission is to develop the whole child – spirit, soul and body. Therefore we offered daily, morning devotions and a school-wide, weekly Chapel service filled with praise, worship, teaching of the Word and fun.

Our in-person and virtual field trips, intramural sports activities and after school clubs allowed our scholars to connect outside of the virtual classroom.

We provide a Spanish class to increase our scholars' ability to minister to others in our diverse culture.

Our FCA Staff continues the commitment to excellence in education and preparing children to live out the plan and purpose God has ordained for their lives. We formed a professional learning community to review data, curriculum content and state standards to develop strategies to meet the needs of our scholars.



"I am writing on behalf of my husband and I to give a testimony about how the Lord provided for us miraculously after a long six-year battle with the IRS. My husband is an entrepreneur and engaged with a CPA firm who improperly prepared our company and personal taxes for three years, resulting in us owing back taxes to the IRS dating back to 2016. We eventually retained a new CPA firm that helped us to amend our improperly prepared tax returns, which resulted in the IRS owing US a very large refund for the same years in which they said we owed them.

Because of my husband's company, he was assigned an IRS agent whose responsibility was to collect back taxes from businesses. We were required work with him to make arrangements to pay what the IRS thought we owed them. The IRS agent was very aggressive, was difficult to work with and showed up to my husband's office and threatened my husband with jail. Eventually we were assigned a new agent, but God gave us favor with him - he was kind and assisted us in unraveling our very long and complex tax history. He worked with his supervisor to conduct a forensic analysis of our tax file to determine what our true obligations were and what the IRS owed us. However, while this was going on, we were still receiving constant notices from a different department within the IRS with demands for payment and threats to levy our bank accounts and place liens on our property. During this whole ordeal, we prayed and agreed for an end to this ordeal and for our refund to be paid to us with no further obligation to pay any more money to the IRS when they, in fact, owed us.

In 2019, Bishop Butler spoke a word of knowledge at the end of a Sunday service and said that "someone here is dealing with a tax issue and your issue will be completely resolved". My husband and I were encouraged and grabbed hold to that word. We thanked God in advance for the victory and that word was a constant source of faith and peace for us as we continued to deal with this issue for yet another three years.

In the fall of 2021, we finally paid all that the IRS said that we owed them based on the previous incorrect returns and our file with the agent was closed, but we were still waiting on them to refund us. We received a letter from the IRS indicating that



they acknowledged that they owed us, but they were holding our refund in order to determine if we owed them any more money. It felt like we were never going to see an end to this issue and were tempted to give up, but we continued to believe God and say what HE said about the matter and praise Him for the victory, even when the situation looked contrary.

We continued to wait month after month for the next year for our refund, during which time, we attempted to contact the IRS to find out why our money wasn't being refunded. Finally, in late September of 2022, my husband was led by the Holy Spirit to contact the agent who was assigned to us previously to seek his counsel and assistance. After we emailed him, he acknowledged and released the improper hold on our account. IN OCTOBER 2022, AFTER SIX YEARS OF BATTLE, WE RECEIVED OUR REFUND OF OVER \$130,000 WITH INTEREST!!!

Also, the refund came at the right time - at a time when the company was faced with reduced revenues and cash flows due to staffing shortages - so we weren't receiving any income in our household and were using our personal emergency funds to pay our bills, and these funds were rapidly being depleted.

We thank and praise God for his favor, faithfulness, miraculous provision and protection. We could have lost everything, but God made the way and preserved us, and He gave us the victory."


